# a. PROVINCIAL UNION REQUIREMENTS

### • Annual General Meetings

- i. Hold Annual General Meeting
- ii. Elect Union Executives & Management
- iii. Submit Union Schedule and Activities
- iv. Submit Union Financial Report
- v. Submit Other Union Matters & Projects

# COVID-19 Return to Play awareness Protocols

- i. Appoint a Medical Coordinator
- ii. The Medical Coordinator MUST complete the COVID-19 Return to Play awareness Protocols training
- iii. The Medical Coordinator will train one member from each club COVID-19 Return to Play awareness Protocols

### • MCIL Certificate of Incorporated Society (updated annually)

- i. Submit MCIL Certificate
- ii. Submit AGM report
- iii. Submit Audited Financial Accounts

### Annual Affiliated Union Subscription to LAKAPI SAMOA

- i. Submit MCIL Certificate
- ii. Submit Club Registrations
- iii. Submit Player Registrations
- iv. Pay annual subscription \$300 Tala

### Club Competition

- i. Appoint Competitions Committee
- ii. Appoint a Match Commissioner / Tournament Director
- iii. Appoint Disputes & Disciplinary Committee
- iv. Appoint Referees Manager
- v. Hold Club competition which consists of 7s, 10s or 15s rugby tournaments for both women and men.
- vi. Facilitate Club Subscriptions and submit to LAKAPI SAMOA
- vii. Facilitate Player Registrations and submit to LAKAPI SAMOA
- viii. Facilitate Referees Register and submit to LAKAPI SAMOA
- ix. Ensure Clubs have Player Insurance Cover under ACC (tbc)
- x. Ensure Player Welfare is paramount during all matches and tournaments
- xi. Ensure First Aid / Red Cross Assistance at all matches or tournaments
- xii. Ensure Ground Security at all matches or tournaments (Police and/or Village Council)
- xiii. Ensure Field of Play Dimensions & Marking are in line with World Rugby requirements
- xiv. Update Tournament Manual / Rules from LAKAPI SAMOA
- xv. Grow Women's Rugby at all levels in the district, from primary schools to secondary schools to clubs.
- xvi. Weekly submission of Competition Results to LAKAPI SAMOA
- xvii. Interact with stakeholders, fans and supporters through social media outlets and keep the public informed of union events and activities.

# • Field & Venue Requirements

- i. Field MUST meet rugby field dimensions
- ii. Field surface MUST be safe for playing rugby
- iii. Rugby venue MUST have running water and power
- iv. Venue MUST have changing rooms / areas for participating teams, referees and union officials
- v. Venue MUST have fully functional bathrooms / toilets for officials and public
- vi. Venue MUST have a proper fence around the field perimeter for security.

### • Player Registrations

- i. Player Details (Name, Position, DOB, Occupation, Club & Contacts)
- ii. Copy of Player's Birth Certificate / Passport
- iii. Player Headshots
- iv. Team Player Registration Lists
- v. Submit Player Registration Database

### • District Zoning for Clubs

- i. All village clubs MUST play in their district zones.
- ii. No village club is allowed to register outside of its district zone.
- iii. If a club is caught playing in a club competition instead of its district zone, that club will face sanctions directly from LAKAPI SAMOA as well as the provincial union harbouring the club.
- iv. If there is no club competition in a club's district union, then that club may register in an active union nearby.





## Women's Rugby

- i. It is an LAKAPI SAMOA Requirement to have a Women's Rugby Competitions in all Provincial Union
- ii. Must have a women's competition incorporated in the men's competition, either 7's, 10's or 15's
- iii. Must encourage clubs to have women's teams and have women involved in each club
- iv. Must also encourage women to be involved in Union executive committees, referees association, coaching, trainer, medical personnel, judiciary and match commissioners; so that women are well represented within the union.

### Referees Association

- i. It is a LAKAPI SAMOA Requirement to have a Referees Association in each Provincial Union
- ii. Keep annual register of referees
- iii. Referees must attend LAKAPI SAMOA referees courses for upskilling and update on laws of the game and any variations trialled by LAKAPI SAMOA or World Rugby.

### U19s Competition

- vi. After the review in 2020, all Franchise teams and Provincial Unions agreed to change the U20s competition to U19s Competition.
- vii. Therefore the NPC / Super Lakapi will have an U19s competition NOT U20s.
- viii. Therefore all Provincial Unions must commence with U19s competitions for the year 2022.
- ix. Age eligibility is a player born in the years 2003 and 2004.
- x. If a player born in 2005 wishes to play, then that player must fill a consent form from his parents or guardian for clearance.
- xi. If a player born in 2002 or a year before 2002, that player is deemed over-age and will face disciplinary action along with sanctions against management and team

### Super Lakapi Requirement to be associated in a Franchise

- i. Unions MUST complete its union requirements above in order to be involved in the Franchise.
- ii. If a Union is in-active, then that Union is disqualified from being involved in the Franchise.
- iii. If all Unions in a Franchise are in-active, then that Franchise is also disqualified from the Super Lakapi tournament.
